## 2025 Quality Improvement Activity #2: Potentially Avoidable Emergency Department Visits or Potentially Preventable Admissions Strategy Form

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) penalizes health plans that have a high rate of avoidable emergency room visits or potentially preventable admissions.
