Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) has made the following updates to the 2024 Global Quality (GQ) P4P IPA Program Guide:

NEW Measure

Depression Screening and Follow-Up for Adolescents and Adults (DSF-E):

- **Measure Description:** The percentage of Members 12 years of age and older screened for clinical depression during the measurement year (2024) using a standardized instrument and, if screened positive, received follow-up care in the measurement year (2024).
 - This measure will assess the depression screening and follow-up care for those Members who screen positive for depression.
 - Please reference the **2024 Global Quality P4P Program Guide** for full details on screening tools.
