Subject: Topical Fluoride (TFL) Application in Primary Care Setting

Primary Care Physicians (PCPs) play an important role in preventing Early Childhood Caries (ECC). Through the application of fluoride varnish, PCPs can effectively reduce the risk of ECC and promote optimal oral health in children.

Topical fluoride application is included in the 2024 and 2025 Global Quality (GQ) Pay-For-Performance (P4P) and Urgent Care + Wellness incentive programs. If you are not already applying topical fluoride in your practice, please consider completing a training certification course so you may begin offering this service to your members 1 year through 20.99 years of age.

Topical Fluoride Training Certification

This resource includes instructional videos and an exam that upon completion can be printed or posted as proof of certification for audit purposes. Please note that the 2024 Medical Record Review (MRR) standards, found here, include the requirements for documentation of Topical Fluoride application.

Billing Topical Fluoride Application

Please note when billing for dental fluoride varnish that the medical (CPT) codes for this service should be utilized by PCPs and the dental (CDT) codes should be utilized only by dental professionals.
