Subject: Quality Improvement Best Practices - Rotavirus Vaccine

We are pleased to share quality improvement best practices for childhood immunizations that can help providers improve their Pay for Performance (P4P).

ROTARIX is now supplied as a prefilled oral dosing applicator.

The Rotarix oral formulation (CPT Code for Vaccine: 90681) eliminates the need for reconstitution or dilution, simplifying the administration process. The Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) recommended 2-dose series makes it easier to complete the rotavirus series, which positively impacts immunization coverage and healthcare providers' P4P for the Childhood Immunization Status - Combination 10 (CIS-10) measure.

IEHP data shows that members are more likely to complete the Rotavirus series when they start the 2-dose series compared to the 3-dose series.

The Vaccine for Children (VFC) Program supplies Rotarix prefilled oral dosing applicator. The first oral dose can be administered to VFC-eligible infants as early as 6 weeks of age, with a minimum 4-week interval until the second dose. Complete the two-dose series by 24 weeks. If an infant spits out most of the dose, consider a single replacement dose during the same visit.

Summary of Recommendation:

We encourage use of the 2-dose Rotarix oral formulation to help increase the completion rate of the rotavirus series and positively impact the CIS-10 measure. The Rotarix oral formulation (CPT Code for Vaccine: 90681) aligns with IEHP's goal to enhance the delivery of childhood immunizations and help providers improve their P4P.
